SustaMID (Nylon), SustaRIN (Acetal), SustaDUR (PET), SustaABS, SustaPPE, SustaVACU, SustaNAT (Polycarbonate), SustaPVDF, SustaPEEK, SustaSON (PSU,PES,PPSU, SustaPEI, SustaTRON (PPS), SustaGLIDE, Sustakon, Polystone G (HDPE), Polystone D (HMW), Polystone M (UHMW), Polystone P (Polypropylene)

- a) Do not contain any of the 211 substances (stated in the "[candidates list](#)" ECHA/NR/21/05 dated 19th January 2021 in a non-conform single concentration of more than 0.1 in percentage of weight.
- b) Do not contain any of the 69 substances and/or groups of substances, in unauthorised quantities or applications, which are stated in the current version of the [ANNEX XVII](#) of the REACH guidelines, 21st February 2021.
- c) Do not contain any of the 54 substances and/or groups of substances, unauthorised quantities or applications, which are stated in the current version of the [ANNEX XIV](#) of the REACH guidelines dated 7th February 2020.

This is in accordance with present day status of knowledge and corresponds to data provided by our supplier. Should the candidates' list change and new substances listed there be contained with a non-conforming percentage in weight we will endeavour to make this information available.
